

## Bon Secours Memorial School of Nursing in Richmond, VA

### Announces New Hampton Roads Clinical Site

Effective with our incoming Fall, 2009 class, Bon Secours Memorial School of Nursing will offer a unique opportunity for students residing in Hampton Roads. Students will be able to pursue their Registered Nurse training through our fully accredited school in Richmond, while completing their clinical training and general education studies locally.

The Program:

Students have two choices: day and evening/weekend options.

**Daytime classes:** The day students will attend lectures in Richmond one day per week and complete their clinical (hands on) training at clinical sites in Hampton Roads, beginning with Mary Immaculate Hospital one day per week. Other clinical sites in Hampton Roads will be used to meet course requirements as needed. Throughout the 30-month program, the student's general education courses (such as English, math, sciences, etc.) will be taken at their local community college through a reciprocal agreement with Bon Secours Memorial School of Nursing.

**Evening option:** Students choosing this schedule will attend lectures in Richmond one night per week, and have their clinical (hands-on) training every/other Saturday, beginning at Mary Immaculate Hospital in Newport News. Other clinical sites in Hampton Roads will be used to meet course requirements as needed. Throughout the 30-month program, the student's general education courses (such as English, math, sciences, etc.) will be taken at their local community college through a reciprocal agreement with Bon Secours Memorial School of Nursing.

The length of the program is typically completed in 30 months. Students attend classes year round, including summers. At the conclusion, students are eligible to take the NCLEX exam to become licensed as a Registered Nurse.

Bon Secours Virginia employees and their immediate family members will be eligible for a discount off our tuition costs. In addition, students who accept employment with any Bon Secours Virginia hospital will be eligible for our loan pay-back program.
