



**Explanation of BSMSON Fees**

1. Health Assessment Fee (non-refundable) is not covered by insurance.
2. Uniform includes designated school uniform, shoes, hose, lab coat, stethoscope and watch with a second hand.
3. Graduation fee covers the cost of a school pin, diploma, luncheon and cost of graduation.
4. Criminal Background Check fee of \$60 (non-refundable) is paid directly to the background check company. Background checks are required for many of the clinical rotation sites. An updated background check is required each year. All students who have completed one background check with Verified Credentials, Inc., the BSMSON background check company, can update it for \$32.00 per year for each of the remaining years at BSMSON.
5. A Virginia Child Protective Services background report is required annually. This fee will be billed through the School, provided your application is turned-in on time.
6. Fingerprinting is required annually. The \$30 management fee is paid directly to the management company and must be paid prior to submitting your fingerprint card and documents. Additionally, the Police Department may charge up to \$15.00 for rolling your fingers to obtain your prints.
7. Students are charged program fees (learning resource, health, activity) each semester they are enrolled in either nursing and/or general education courses, unless they are on an approved Medical Leave.

**Additional Costs**

1. Students should make allowances for books, supplies and other out-of-pocket expenses when figuring the total cost of education.
2. Hospitalization insurance is required at student expense. Proof of insurance is required.
3. Transportation and parking fees are the student's responsibility.
4. Returned check charge for all fees is \$25.
5. MCAT retake test fee is \$25.00.
6. Computer disks are \$.25 each.
7. Official transcripts are \$5.00 each.

**Terms of Payment**

1. Payment of tuition and fees are due ten (10) days before the start of each semester.
2. JSRCC tuition for required classes is included on your bill at BSMSON. Students must report to the Registrar and follow BSMSON procedures when enrolling for required classes at JSRCC or any other institution.
3. Students who have enrolled in JSRCC courses and have already paid for those courses should remit a proof of payment to the Bursar so that their accounts can be credited.
4. Students retaking a class are responsible for the tuition and fees.
5. Students who are in grade appeal and have started another class are responsible for the tuition and fees.
6. Students who have been unsuccessful in two classes and are in grade appeal are responsible for the tuition and fees of a class if they have continued in the program during the grade appeal process.
