Policy Statement:

A faculty academic advisor works with each student to determine the appropriate schedule based on courses completed. A diploma in nursing is awarded at the completion of the program requirements and graduates are eligible to take the licensure examination for the registered nurse.

The nursing courses progress in the curriculum based on the program outcomes, level competencies, course objectives, teaching methods, and evaluation methods. Courses at BSMSON are taught within a 16-week semester unless otherwise noted. The curriculum planning guide depicts the curriculum plan used for planning academic progression through the BSMSON diploma program.

Nursing courses must be taken according to the time frame designated in the curriculum plan. All prerequisites must be met before the student progresses each semester. Policy CUR 1.11 depicts BSMSON and JSRCC required course prerequisites. The Assistant Dean of Curriculum and Instruction must be notified of any changes that affect the nursing curriculum progression. Upon acceptance to the BSMSON diploma program, students will enroll as either a day or evening class student. This cannot be changed without the approval of the Assistant Dean of Curriculum and Instruction.

Any changes in the curriculum plan needs to be made in collaboration with the student's faculty academic advisor. A revised curriculum plan needs to be completed by the advisor and placed in the student file by the registrar. Any changes to the curriculum plan resulting in the student changing their original plan may result in requested courses not being available to the student.
