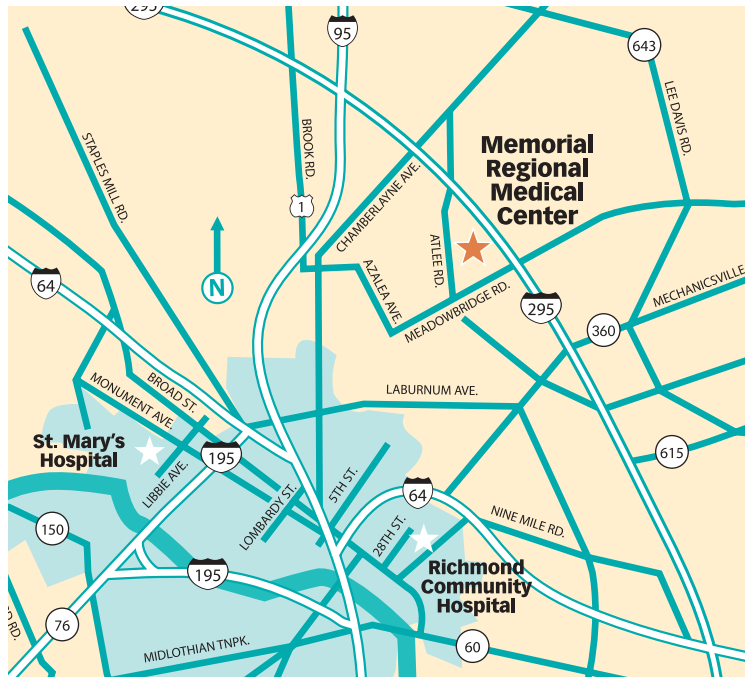

Directions

From North: Take 1-95 South to 1-295 South. Take exit 38B onto Meadowbridge Road (Rt. 627). Make a right onto Atlee Road and travel approximately 1/2 mile to entrance on right.

From South: Take 1-95 North to 1-295 South. Take exit 38B onto Meadowbridge Road (Rt. 627). Make a right onto Atlee Road and travel approximately 1/2 mile to entrance on right.

From East: Take 360 West to 1-295 North. Take Exit 38B onto Meadowbridge Road (Rt. 627). Make a right onto Atlee Road and travel approximately 1/2 mile to entrance on right.

Memorial Regional Medical Center



Bon Secours Memorial Regional Medical Center, Hanover County's first full service acute care hospital, is a 225-bed all private room facility offering a wide variety of healthcare specialties. It proudly serves the medical needs of suburban Hanover and Henrico Counties, rural Virginia's Northern Neck, and the city of Richmond; and is easily accessed by Interstate 295 and Route 360.

This modern facility, celebrating its fifth anniversary in 2003, provides the latest medical technologies and an innovative approach to the delivery of family centered care. Memorial Regional offers a full spectrum of healthcare services for families including acute care, ambulatory services and a 24-hour emergency room. It also features the region's only labor, delivery, recovery and postpartum rooms in its birthing center.

Other key services on our campus are diagnostic and treatment facilities, physical rehabilitation, radiation therapy, urology and physician practices, including primary care and subspecialties.

Imaging

This newly renovated center features a complete array of inpatient and outpatient radiology services including diagnostic radiology, fluoroscopy, mammography, ultrasound, cat scan, MRI, nuclear medicine, and angiography/interventional radiology. The GE Light-Speed CT scanner captures four times the information of previous scanners in a fraction of the time, providing physicians with the clearest CT images possible.

Oncology

The program offers both inpatient and outpatient oncology treatment and is staffed by nurses certified in oncology treatment techniques. The Cancer Information Center, as well as alternative therapies and support groups are available to patients and their families. The services of Hospice and Palliative Care are also available.

Cardiac Surgery & Cardiology

Memorial Regional's cardiac surgery and cardiology outcomes have been recognized nationally. Complete cardiac care is available ranging from non-invasive procedures to cardiac surgery and cardiovascular rehabilitation. The Innova 2000, the world's first all-digital cardiovascular imaging system, is available to Memorial Regional's patients and provides a sharper, clearer image so blockages can be pinpointed with precision.

Emergency Medicine

Serving an extensive geographic area, Memorial Regional's Emergency Department treats more than 37,000 patients annually and has become one of the busiest centers in the Greater Richmond area. To accommodate this rapid growth, expansion of the department is underway. The department is open 24 hours.

The Joint Replacement Center

The Joint Replacement Center specializes in the care of patients requiring shoulder, knee, and hip replacements, performing hundreds of these procedures annually. Pre-operative education is offered to our patients.

Our team of dedicated physicians, therapists, nurses and care managers provide a comprehensive and hands-on approach to your treatment and recovery.

Orthopaedics

This 20-bed unit features all private rooms designed for the comfort and convenience of the post-surgical orthopaedic patient. The recently renovated rooms feature handicapped-accessible private baths and rehabilitation charts.

Surgical Services

The Surgical Services Department provides specialized care in the following surgical specialties: Cardiothoracic, Vascular, Gynecology, Orthopaedics and Sports Medicine Services, Ear, Nose and Throat, Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery, Ophthalmology, Urology, Microscopic Hand Surgery, Laser-Assisted Surgery, Pediatric Surgery and General Surgery.

The most advanced technology is used to provide leading-edge care to all surgical patients. The staff of Surgical Services is dedicated to providing optimum care and personalized services to our patients and their families.

Women's Services

Memorial Regional Medical Center provides a full range of comprehensive women's health services, caring for women at every stage of life.

Memorial Regional offers a full range of women's diagnostic services, including mammography with the advanced breast biopsy instrumentation system. Memorial Regional also offers routine and advanced gynecological surgery such as minimally invasive surgery techniques for women of all ages.

For expectant parents, the birthing center offers beautiful birthing suites, or LDRPs (labor/delivery/recovery/postpartum). Most mothers will stay in the same birthing suite from the time they enter the hospital until they go home. Care in the birthing center is



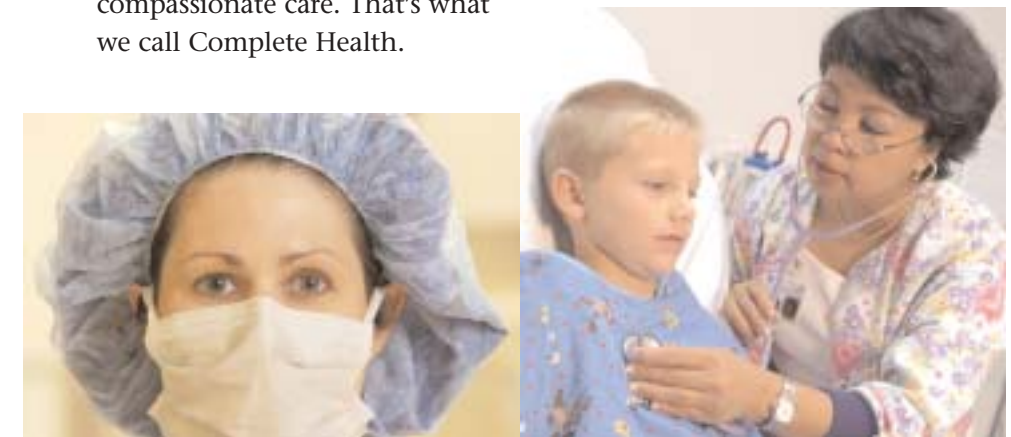
highly flexible and family-centered, and both physicians and certified nurse-midwives are available. The Love & Learn education program, Bon Secours Baby Club and lactation consultants support parents during pregnancy, birth and parenting. While most births are completely healthy, we also offer neonatal intensive care services (NICU) and Bon Secours NICU.net™, a free computer-access system for parents of premature infants.
