Richmond Community Hospital is a 104-bed acute care facility conveniently located in Richmond's historic Church Hill. The hospital maintains a proud heritage of providing expert health care to the residents of the City of Richmond for more than 100 years. Richmond Community Hospital offers the services of an award-winning Emergency Department and a wide variety of other health care specialties.

Emergency Medicine

Richmond Community Hospital has been named a Top Performer for emergency room patient satisfaction. The Emergency Care Center is open 24 hours a day and is staffed with a team of highly trained emergency care professionals.

Surgery

The Department of Surgery provides new and innovative procedures including general surgery, vascular and intravascular procedures, dialysis access, orthopaedics, laparoscopic surgery, laser procedures and breast tumor management.

Medical Imaging

The hospital offers 24-hour comprehensive diagnostic imaging services including CT scan, MRI, nuclear medicine, ultrasound and mammography. Nuclear cardiology services are also offered.

Endoscopy

This unit provides “a touch of excellence” to patients with gastrointestinal disorders through upper endoscopy, colonoscopy, paracentesis and liver biopsy procedures.



Behavioral Health

A 36-bed unit is staffed with a professional and compassionate team of physicians and psychiatric nurses, offering acute psychiatric and detox stabilization as well as 24-hour emergency psychiatric evaluation through the Emergency Department.

Specialties

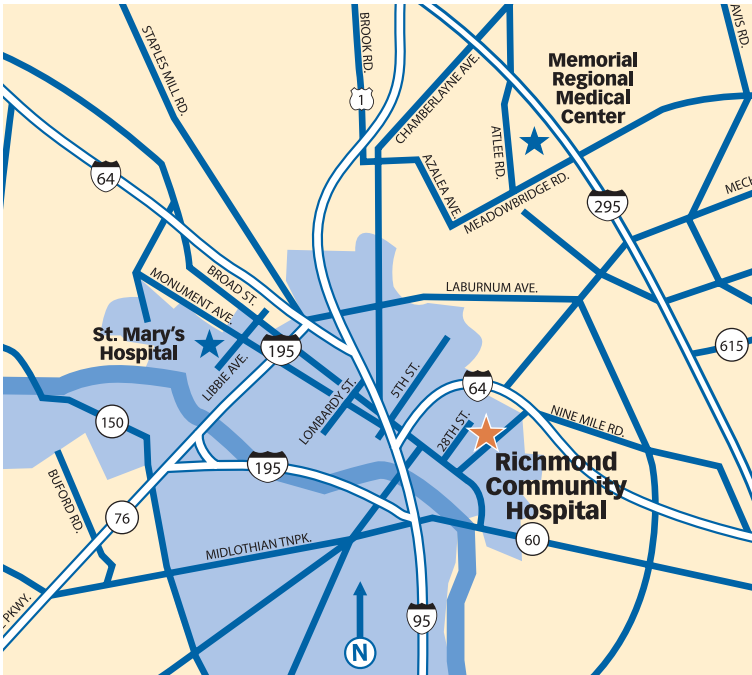
Richmond Community Hospital offers a wide variety of healthcare specialties including:
