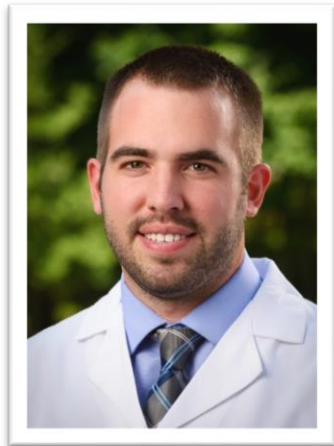

**Why SFFM?** “Unopposed Family Medicine training in a community setting with thorough training in OB care and Sports Medicine.”

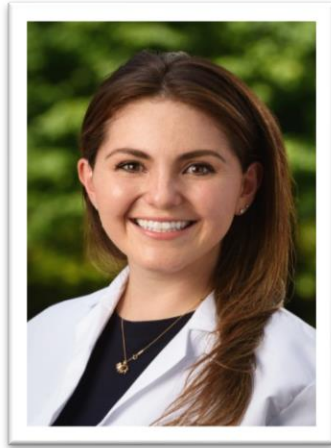
