Five-year average job placement rate of not less than 75% within one year post-graduation

Year	Percent Job Placement	# of Graduates employed/# of graduates actively seeking employment
2016	100%	13 graduates - 11 respondents: 11 gained employment/11 actively seeking employment (2 no responses)
2017	100%	10 graduates – 10 respondents: 10 gained employment/10 actively seeking employment
2018	100%	14 graduates – 14 respondents: 14 gained employment/14 actively seeking employment
2019	100%	13 graduates – 13 respondents: 13 gained employment/13 actively seeking employment
2020	91.67%	12 graduates – 12 respondents: 11 gained employment/1 not actively seeking employment due to care for parents during pandemic. (not a JRCERT defined reason for “not” actively seeking)
5-year average (2016-2020)	98.3%	59 gained employment/ 59 actively seeking employment/2 no responses/1 not seeking employment

The JRCERT has defined “not actively seeking employment” as:

1. Graduate fails to communicate with program officials regarding employment status after multiple attempts
OR
2. Graduate is unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation
OR
3. Graduate is unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours
OR
4. Graduate is on active military duty
OR
5. Graduate is continuing education.

Annual program completion rate should not be less than 75%

2020	75%	12 graduates/16 initial cohorts (1 withdrew, 3 dismissed)
